- When delivered to the Show site, all entries must be accompanied by a description of the item, the method of construction (if applicable) and the woods used (if known). Maximum 150 words
- It will be the responsibility of the entrant to arrange delivery to and pick-up from the Show site.
- The Competition is open to all woodworkers resident in Australia.
- The judging panel will be led by woodworking educator and The Australian Woodworker Associate Editor, Les Miller. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- While it is the intention to exhibit all entries at the Show, Skills Publishing and dmg world media reserve the right to exclude entries from exhibition.
